



The first section of the <u>Administrative Resolution of May 18th, 2022</u>, by the Direcció General de Política Lingüística i Gestió del Multilingüisme, which establishes the calendar and the process of admission and enrolment for the academic year 2022-2023 in the official schools of languages of the Valencian Community, establishes the conditions for admission.

The following table lists the academic requirements needed for accessing a level higher to the initiation one (A2) for each language.

A2, B1, B2 or C1 certificate or any other accepted certificate stipulated in annex I (English), annex II (French), annex III (German), annex IV (Italian), and annex V (Valencian) of the Resolution. Example: FCE (First Certificate in English)	Level following the one certified> Ex. 1C1 of English
Cambridge University Three parts of the Unified Certification Test (PUC) in a previous call	Last course of the level failed in the Unified Certification Test

Note: "1B1" means "first academic year of B1 level". Every language has a different level distribution. Sometimes, they only have one academic year per level, which means that there might be a 1B1 level but not a 2B1.
